Policy Agenda: Unpaid Care Work and Climate Justice

ActionAid Ethiopia will lead on influencing the agenda of Unpaid Care Work. Unpaid Care Work is considered part of women's and girls' reality as a result of patriarchal underpinnings that has affected the social fabric and the mainstream economic models from household to global level.

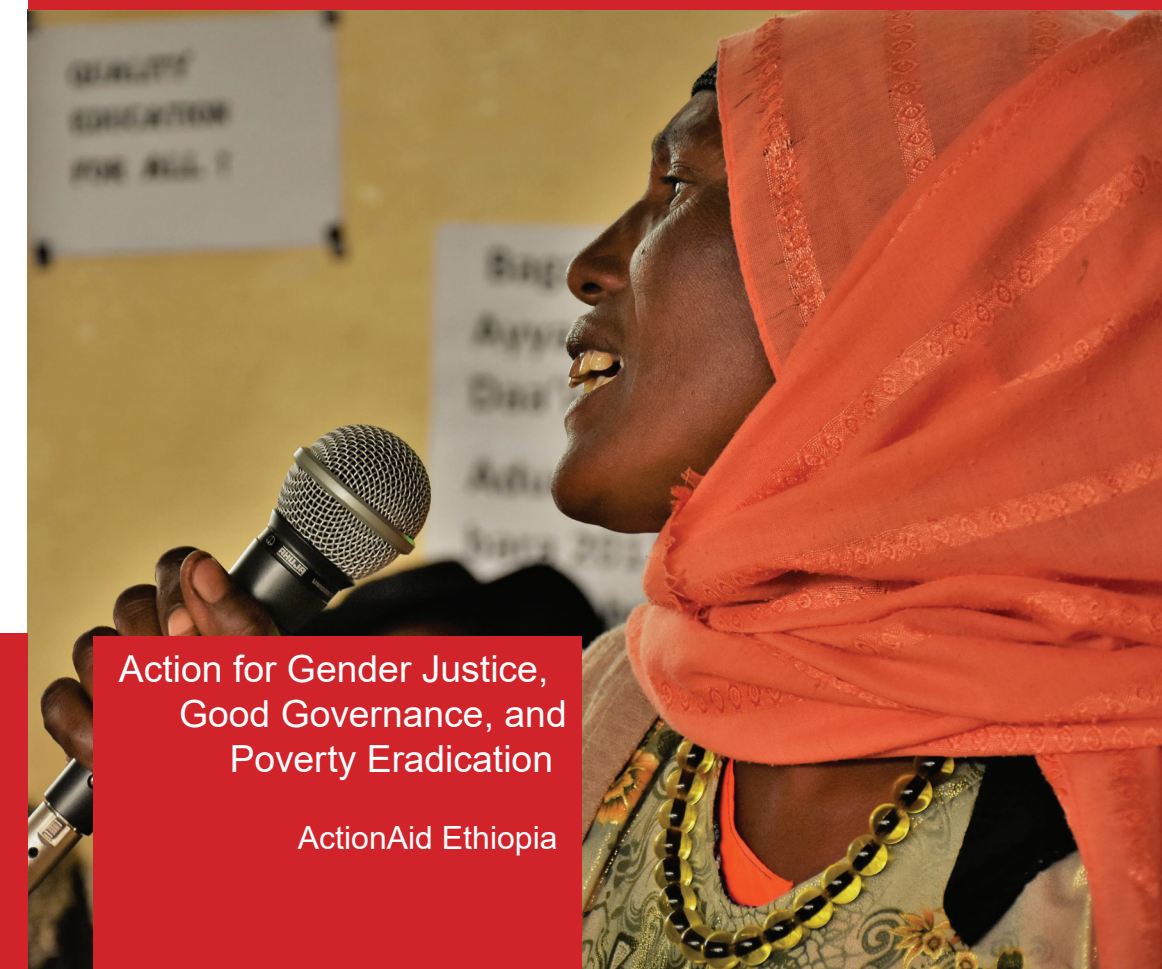
